How we are funded

100% of the program's funding comes from the federal-aid State Planning and Research (SPR), Part II Research program.

What we do

The Research Division manages MDOT SHA's state and national research programs, including the annual Research Work program and participation in Transportation Research Board (TRB) and National Cooperative Highway Research Program (NCHRP) activities. Additional activities include serving as a member of AASHTO's Research Advisory Committee (RAC), and serving as the TRB State Representative for Maryland. The Division also maintains close working relationships with MDOT SHA's university research partners.
