Reflections on the Wichita meeting

- Meeting room was too large
- Difficult taking notes remotely
- Joe asked whether the presentation in the meeting was a good idea.
 - o Emily complimented Binh Bui's presentation on Georgia's program management database two years ago.
 - 49-07 would be good to present next year. This should probably be presented to all RAC, not just to PM&Q
- Emily asked a question about the best way to find out what happened to projects, such as 20-111J. Will this info be disseminated through PM&Q?
 - Jason Bittner said the 20-111J (2 CFR200) survey was just sent out and there will be a TRB webinar on this topic in February/March 2019, after the TRB Annual Meeting
 - Joe Horton will add this topic to the list for PM&Q or full RAC meeting agenda in 2019.
 [Follow-up item #2 Joe Horton]
- David talked about the overall 20-111 project series. This is NCHRP's support for RAC and will last a few years. There are multiple projects under it and RAC will add more topics.
- Emily is interested in getting periodic updates on those and will contact Chris Hedges or Lori Sundstrom.
- Joe Horton agreed that 20-111 is research for RAC, so the project coordinator should update whole RAC on project progress.

July 25 Task Force Meeting Minutes were approved.

PM&Q ACTION PLAN

- The Action Plan was developed in 2012.
- Joe Horton sent out an updated Action Plan and emphasized that he wanted this to be a living document
- He asked each subgroup to update their own page. He will also add a section for Chair and Co-Chair (their roles and responsible actions).
- Joe's desire is to break the task force activities into small steps, small pieces, so it's not too intimidating and we can celebrate small accomplishments.
- Joe clarified the purpose of "Assisting" line under each subgroup (to solicit help from volunteers on subgroup activities).
- Meredith wants to volunteer to help on some of these projects.

- Joe will be glad to sit in on meetings/calls of the various subgroups and help with keeping this living document up-to-date

SUBGROUP ACTIVITIES

Research Implementation – Joe C.:

- Next meeting on October 10
- Joe C. and Binh Bui are currently reviewing the subgroup's web presence.
 - Found 60 implementation-related documents on RPPM. Also documents/information elsewhere.
 - Want to have a single location for implementation
- Working on implementation-related sessions at both RAC summer meeting and TRB annual meeting
- Two sessions at 2019 TRB Annual Meeting.

Program Management Tools – Tommy:

- Both HVR Research Submission and transportation pooled fund websites are running very well,
 and we have enough money for the maintenance
- There is no request to resurrect the RPM (Research Performance Measures) website.
- This group is currently just waiting for next marching orders. They are in a maintenance mode.
- David mentioned the project management tool they have developed at GDOT.
 - Finished the Implementation Tracking Tool
 - o Piloted on 20 projects. The pilot went well.
 - o Presented to Leadership. An Annual Implementation Report is in process.
 - o Hope to combine this tracking tool with a project management database.
- Looking to take this to be able to do program-level analysis and can produce a return-oninvestment report.
- David will get back to PM&Q with update after talking with Binh Bui. [Follow-up item #4]
- David answered Enid's question about whether the tool is Excel-based. The implementation tracking tool is Excel-based for now. The combined Research Program Management Database will be in Access eventually.
- David confirmed that the tool will track projects both in-progress and after completion (Joe C.'s question).

Personnel/Administration – David Jared:

Peer Exchange Project 20-111G

Small group formed to review, distill, and provide recommendations to FHWA; about 2/3 done; will transmit to John Moulden soon.

Staffing Levels Project 49-07 "Managing Transportation Research Programs"

- -- waiting for the posting of the final report. Panel met for the last time in June.
 - May present this at the winter RAC meeting or at next summer's RAC meeting.
 - Original intent was to look at staffing levels and skill sets for research managers. Then was broadened to include research performance measures. Should be wrapping up really soon.
 - David thinks there is a lot in there about performance measures, but less on staffing level side in the final report.

Ahead of the Curve Curriculum (ATOC)

- Getting really close to a decision on a final home for AOTC.
- Before moving ahead with training modules, we want to decide where this program should reside
- **David considering handing this subgroup over to someone else and switching over to C&C.
 - Won't do that until he has someone ready to pick this up.
 - Joe H. asked David if he has suggestions for who would be good to pick up this subgroup.

Quality and Timeliness of Research Deliverables:

- Jen, Binh, and Enid said in July meeting that they would pick up this group.
- Nothing has happened on this yet.
- Jen shared through email that Missouri DOT has published guidelines for researchers.
